Digital connectivity explained

In its most simple terms, connectivity is broadband and a mobile network. The project wants to deliver this to you. Connectivity can work both inside and outside the home via a mixture of wired, wireless and mobile technology supporting the needs of the whole of a rural area.

The solution

To fully understand what we could offer we need to understand your problems. That is why we want to hear your stories.

However, we expect to be able to offer you ultra-fast broadband for the lifetime of the project at no cost to you. In the home or business, this will improve your ability to video call, use games consoles, work from home and connect with customers, for example.

We, also, expect to be able to offer you mobile connectivity outside of the home. This will, allow, you to call people via WIFI calling; ease issues for delivery drivers, social care teams and Emergency Services, as well as visitors coming to the area.

Why 5G?

Upgraded infrastructure and new devices allows a 5G network to work more efficiently within frequencies already used in North Yorkshire and the UK. In order to bring rural areas onto a level playing field we need to explore how it can work effectively with the rural landscape.
