#### **Key Statistics**


Between 1st December 2020 and 31st January 2021 we helped **3,000** people (59% had a disability or a long-term health condition). **£1,589,679** of financial gains, including benefits and tax credits.

#### Warm and Well in North Yorkshire



Between October and December, the team dealt with **393** referrals which was an increase of **210** calls for the same period in 2019. With funding secured from Energy Saving Trust we supported **173** households with energy top up vouchers.

We continue to support clients with energy switching, queries regarding keeping homes warm, and energy efficiency measures. Working with our partners through the Warm and Well partnership we have been able to support clients to have central heating installed with new Eco rated boilers. Our specialist debt advisors continue to support clients with fuel debt.

We also welcomed Glen and Maciej to the team as part of the Energy Redress project which will mean that we can support **500** households with energy advice across North Yorkshire.
