A684 SAFER ROADS FUND - PATRICK BROMPTON JUNCTION IMPROVEMENT WORKS

This letter is to inform you that North Yorkshire County Council will be undertaking essential highway improvement works at the above location. The works will be carried out under a combination of road closures and temporary traffic signal control.

Please note that during the construction of the scheme, Brompton Road will be closed to vehicular access at the junction with the A684 in both directions with local signed diversions in place. In addition, two-way temporary traffic signals will be deployed on the A684 to ensure the safe operation of the highway for all users.

The works are currently programmed to commence on 12th July 2021 and are expected to last for up to 7 weeks.

Please note, this work is part of an extensive programme and therefore it is possible that some adjustment to this start date or the duration of the works may be necessary should unforeseen circumstances such as significant weather events or emergencies on the highway network arise. Operatives working on site will be observing all current Government guidelines on safe social distancing.

The works will be carried out between 07:30hrs and 17:30hrs. This may inevitably delay vehicular travel but we will endeavour to reduce delay times during the working period. We request your assistance in the following ways: -

- Please contact the Site Supervisor on 07753 813247 to advise of any special access needs you may require during the work period;
- Cooperate and comply with any instructions issued by site staff and the Traffic Safety & Control Officer and take extra care whilst near the works area.
